Acts 2

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled [the whole temple] where they were sitting. (Acts 2:1)

They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. (Acts 2:3-4)

“In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy.” (Acts 2:17-18)

Study Questions

1. Can you recall an event that drastically changed your life for the better?
2. The disciples had an intimate relationship with Jesus and watched as their Lord ascended into heaven (Acts 1). How would the coming of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost have changed everything for the disciples?
3. What was the significance of the Holy Spirit coming during the festival of Pentecost? What realization did those listening have, knowing those speaking were Galileans?
4. What were the differences between what the disciples knew about the Holy Spirit before Pentecost, and after they had experienced him that day? How did Peter's sermon demonstrate his new understanding of God's gift of the Holy Spirit?

Reflection

1. Do you need to discover a relationship with Jesus? Call the church office and talk to us about it.
2. Do you need to discover or rediscover a relationship with the Holy Spirit? Set aside time this week to talk to the Holy Spirit.
 - Specifically tell Him that you want a relationship with Him

 - Begin a conversation with Him
