Reflection Questions

1. What circumstances in a person's life could lead them to favour a sight-based faith? Consider how that might affect them coming to faith in God/developing a word-based faith.
2. Pastor Stephen gave the definition of Principle of Faith—A person will behave in a way that is consistent with what they believe. Think of examples where this is true for you?
3. What are things you can actively do in your life to keep your faith focused on the promises of God (word-based faith) rather than the circumstances of life (sight-based faith)?
4. Think of stories in the Bible where God was gracious and appealed to people who operated on sight-based faith? What does that say about the character of God?
